Who can participate?

All undergraduate and graduate students, from all CSU campuses and community colleges, doing research in any social science field. Individual and group papers are both welcome.

What is it?

An opportunity to present your research to your peers and compete for a cash award. Presentations will be approximately 12-15 minutes. There will be four \$1000 awards for best undergraduate paper, best graduate paper, best use of quantitative data, and best use of qualitative data in a paper. Runners-up will receive a \$200 award.

How do I participate?

Submission/registration deadline is **Tuesday April 8 at 11:59pm**. If you want to compete for one of the paper awards, you must submit a full paper (maximum 20 pages). To present your research without competing for an award, you only need to submit an abstract (120-250 words).
